Dear Councillors,

I am writing on behalf of the Vanguard West, East and Boreas Offshore Wind Farms project team to provide an update on the public information events scheduled for 26th February and 7th April in Happisburgh.

**The events of 26th and 7th have been cancelled, and we will now hold one public information event on Tuesday 24th March, from 10:00 – 19:00 at Happisburgh Pavilion, next to the Wenn Evans Centre.**

We have taken the decision to reschedule the events while we complete a routine refresh of our construction plans, which may result in some updated information becoming available to share locally. While postponing engagement activity is not something we do lightly, this type of milestone review is a normal part of offshore wind farm development as projects move through different stages. Taking this step helps ensure that any information shared with communities is accurate, up to date and presented in a clear and consistent way.

We appreciate that local residents and councillors may have been planning to attend on the original dates, and we apologise for any inconvenience caused. We will be using our e-newsletter and project update system to inform registered contacts about these changes but would also be grateful if you could share this information via your own communication channels to ensure we reach as many residents as possible.
